ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROFILE
2022-2023

Purpose

The Mystic Valley Regional Charter School, Parent-Teacher Organization “MVRCS PTO” is pleased to offer the MVRCS PTO Scholarship, which will be presented to graduating Seniors in recognition of their distinction and excellence in volunteerism and community service. The purpose of these awards is to recognize and reward achievements in volunteerism and community service among the students of Mystic Valley Regional Charter School “Mystic Valley.” The goals of the Scholarship are:

To foster volunteerism within the community, and promote the appreciation of both the rights and responsibilities of citizenship within the community.

Perhaps the greatest benefit to volunteering is the sense of accomplishment, pride and satisfaction that the student feels from helping others in need within their community. Those personal benefits are reason enough for students to serve as volunteers; however the other obvious benefit is to the community in which the student has given his or her time and talents to help make a difference. The ideals of volunteerism and service to the school community are at the foundation of the PTO’s mission. It is a natural extension of the PTO’s core mission to celebrate the achievements of volunteerism and community service by students of Mystic Valley.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the MVRCS PTO Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. The applicant must be a graduating Senior from Mystic Valley Regional Charter School.
2. The applicant must submit a completed application package, including all components of the package, during the period beginning April 21, 2023 and ending May 12, 2023.



3. The Scholarship Review Committee will not consider incomplete application packages or application packages that are emailed after the May 12, 2023 deadline.
4. The applicant must be a member in good standing in his or her community and in the school.
5. The applicant must possess a grade point average of 2.0 or better.
6. The applicant must have applied and been accepted to an institution of higher learning or plan on entering the military by May 12, 2023.

Application Package

Each applicant to the MVRCS PTO Scholarship must include the following documentation:

1. A completed MVRCS PTO Scholarship application form.
2. One letter of recommendation. The letter of reference shall be from either option (a) or one from source (b).
 - a. a non-relative representative of a charitable service agency, where the applicant has performed community service submitted on the agency letterhead.
 - b. a non-relative, who has known the applicant for at least a school year and can comment on the applicant's involvement in volunteer activities or community service. This may include a teacher, clergy, neighbor, or family friend.
3. An essay which answers the question: What impact did your volunteer or community service experiences have on you and what did you learn about yourself as a result of your volunteer or community service? The essay should be typed (preferably) or neatly handwritten.



4. A Scholastic Standing and Confirmation of Graduation form (attached to the application) signed by the College Counselor to the applicant's scholastic standing with a Grade Point Average of 2.0 or better and confirming that the applicant will graduate from Mystic Valley Regional Charter School. In lieu of a signature, you may also have an email confirmation of the same information sent by a college counselor directly to tiffanybistocchi@gmail.com under subject line "Scholastic Standing for..." with appropriate student name.

Award

Scholarships shall be awarded annually, subject to the availability of adequate funding for the awards. No applicant shall receive more than one Scholarship from the MVRCS PTO Scholarship.

Conditions of the Award

The MVRCS PTO Scholarship shall be awarded under the following conditions:

1. The recipients of the award will be announced by the Scholarship Review Committee Chairperson, or another designee, no later than May 26, 2023.
2. The Scholarship award shall be presented in the form of a check issued by the MVRCS PTO.
3. Applicants are required to notify the MVRCS PTO Scholarship review committee of any changes in their mailing address or enrollment status at Mystic Valley Regional Charter School.
4. MVRCS PTO reserves the right to alter or discontinue this Scholarship program at any time without notice.
5. All application packages shall be judged fairly and impartially by the Scholarship Review Committee.



6. All information received by the Scholarship Review Committee from the applicant shall be considered confidential and will not be disclosed to anyone other than the Scholarship Review Committee.

7. The Scholarship Review Committee's recommendations shall remain confidential until the time of the award presentation with the exception that the award recipients will be made known to the High School Director prior to the graduation date.

3. The Scholastic Standing and Confirmation of Graduation Form must be signed by one of the college counselors. In lieu of signature, college counselors may send an email confirming the applicant's GPA and anticipated graduation date to tiffanybistocchi@gmail.com. Please use the subject line "Scholastic Standing for..." and the appropriate student name.
